- Perform regularly scheduled jobsite safety audits
- Read and become familiar with contract documents, shop drawing processes, and blueprints
- Process requests for information (RFI) and submittals
- Log change orders and revisions
- Maintain Owner/Architect/Contractor meeting minutes
- Gather, calculate, and compile data for conceptual estimates
- Assist estimator with reviewing and leveling subcontractor quotes for project estimates
- Other duties if required by a formal university-sponsored internship program
